HOUSE RULES

Dress Code

- Proper attire must be worn at all times
- All cosmetics & Toiletries should be kept in own room/assigned space in bathroom. When showering please bring proper clothing or robe

Health, Fire, Safety

- NO SMOKING OR VAPING INSIDE THE HOUSE
- No weapons allowed at any time at Ackorn House.
- Bathrooms must be clean and dry after use. Use the bathmat. All razors/toiletries left behind will be
 disposed of daily. Toilet paper will be supplied. No other paper products are to be flushed down the
 toilets other than toilet paper.
- Any plumbing, heating, electrical and/or water problems must be reported to management immediately

Duties

- All guests will participate in the upkeep and cleanliness of the house
- Guests in each bedroom will be expected to keep that room straightened and clean at all times and no open containers allowed.
- Household chores will be divided among the guests and changed regularly.
- All Guests will be responsible for keeping up their own clothes, sheets, bead spreads and towels

Cooking

- Guests must have their own food & snacks, but must abide by the guidelines
- Snack food and groceries must be kept in the kitchen in proper storage (no bugs)
- Anyone cooking must see to it that they completely clean the kitchen. (Stove, dishes, table, etc.)
- Eat in designated eating areas and clean up immediately after yourself when done.
- Do not eat food or beverages that do not belong to you.
- No dishes left in the sink or drainer

Social

- Guests shall not violate any city ordinance or states laws while residing at Ackorn House.
- All guests will have respect and consideration for others.
- Stealing is unacceptable and will result in discharge.
- Threats or acts of violence will result in immediate discharge. This includes indirect threats made in conversation to others.
- No visitors allowed in the house or backyard. This includes family members and minor children.
- There will be no sexual activity or pornography on the premises at any time.
- No pets of any kind allowed.
- No one is allowed to spend the night. No exceptions.
- All televisions, radios, computers and other electrical equipment are to be turned off at night.

- No loud or excessive noise. TVs, radio, etc. will be listened to at a reasonable volume and off by curfew
- There will be nothing put on the walls that is not authorized. No gang identifying photos, symbols, etc. shall be on display in the house at any time.
- No personal household furnishings may be brought in without permission.
